Community Inspections Ongoing

As part of membership in the Villages of Urbana, homeowners agree to maintain their homes in compliance with community standards, and every home is proactively inspected by VOU staff at least once per year. Spring inspections have begun. Please note the following reminders:

Mulch: Red mulch (or mulch of other colors) is prohibited. All mulch must be wood in tones of brown or black.

Landscape lights: For fewer than 5 small lights spaced at least 4 feet apart and located in mulched planter beds, no application is needed. For more than 5 lights, or for lights that are taller than 12 inches, an application is required.

Garden edgers: An application is not required for the installation of smooth plastic or metal edging that is green or black. All other edger styles require an application. Scalloped or brick edging, or edging of non-standard colors is not permitted. Stacked stone or block edgers or retaining structures must be kept in good repair, particularly around trees and on slopes, as the stones or blocks can slide or become uneven.

Shutters and shingles: Please inspect your home to make sure that all of your shutters and shingles are in place. Now is a good time to order replacements if they are needed.
