Babies and Pool Passes... the Real Scoop

Management staff has been working on pool pass renewals for the community and we very much appreciate all the people who have taken the time to complete the renewal form. If you have not already done so, please visit the web site under E-Forms > Membership Pass Renewal. When it comes to babies and children, please note the following:



- Everyone who enters the pool must have a valid photo ID pass or enter as the guest of someone with a valid photo ID pass. This includes infants and children. You do not need to bring in your baby for a photo. Your new child's pass will bear the word "Infant". You will not need a photo until your child is three year old. For your convenience, we will deliver your child's new pass to your house.

- We have seen a number of forms with new babies, and we send our congratulations to those families! Please note that while we are adding your child's name to the household, we cannot issue a pass to the new baby until we receive payment for it. If you have added a new baby, submitted your form and not received the baby's pass, it may be because you did not pay for it. We do NOT need a photo of the baby. Please submit either a check for \$5 per needed pass, payable to VOU, in the black drop box by the management office, or complete a form for a NEW pass and pay online using a credit card (there is a small convenience fee). Staff will create the pass and deliver it to your door. If you have not paid for a pass by the time pool season starts, the infant will have to enter the pool as a guest, which will use up one of your guest passes.

- Baby pictures are amazingly cute, but not on pool passes for teenagers. Or even ten-year-olds. There is no charge to update a photograph, so please have your growing children stop by the management office for a new photo. They will need to bring their current pass and we will update it right then. Please note that even if you have given your 14-year-old permission to enter the pool without an adult, if the photo is side-facing or otherwise indicates a young child, he or she will still not be able to enter without you. Permission to enter the pool without an adult only applies to children with forward-facing photos, as that indicates they have passed the independent swimming test.
