## VOU Snow Plan

### Management Office Closures

### Tree Work Update

Over the past few years, hundreds of VOU street trees have been damaged by an insect called the ash borer. These trees are now being removed. They will be replaced in the spring with a different species.

### Reminder for Pet Owners

Please remember that pet owners are responsible for the cleanup of their animal's waste. There are numerous boxes throughout the community with dog waste bags for your convenience. If your dog is routinely urinating on someone else's yard, this can cause damage to grass and plants. Please make sure that your animal is not routinely using someone else's private property in this manner. You may be held responsible for damage to plantings and grass caused by waste from your pet.
