2013 Pool Season Update

This year the VOU is moving to “smart” pass technology—so your pool pass will be the ticket for other community facilities as well as the pool. This means that you will need to replace your pass, and there will be a one-time fee for each new pass of \$5 per pass (credit cards accepted on-line, or checks can be made payable to VOU). For all forms, please go to the web site, Resources>eForms>Membership Pass.



If your household already has photo id pool passes and you don't want new pictures for the “smart” pass, please complete and return the 2013 Membership Pass Application/Renewal form for your passes along with your payment. Your previous pictures will automatically be transferred to your newly created passes.

If your household already has photo ID pool passes and you do want new pictures for the “smart” pass, follow the instructions above and return the 2013 Pool Pass Application/Renewal form for your passes to be activated for the 2013 swimming season. Allow at least three business days to process the form, then visit the community management office at the Natelli Community Center at 9023 Harris Street to create your photo.

If you are new to the community, have never applied for a pool pass, or have a new member of your household, please submit the 2013 Membership Pass Application/Renewal e-form. Allow at least three business days to process the form, then visit the community management office at the Natelli Community Center at 9023 Harris St to create your photo ID. The office is open daily from 10 AM to 4 PM, and some evening and Saturday hours (please check the webstie for these times). If those hours are not convenient for you, please contact the community management office at 301-831-4810 or by email at info@villagesofurbana.net to make an appointment. When you come to the office for your photo ID, you will need to show proof of residency with a driver's license, a utility bill, or a government-issued document with your address.
