## Traffic Meeting Held

A community meeting to discuss the county's newly implemented parking restrictions on Ethan Ridge Drive was held on Thursday, February 16 at the Shafer's Mill Recreation Center. Representatives from the Frederick County Department of Transportation attended to listen to resident concerns about parking and speeding on Ethan Ridge Drive. Approximately 25 residents attended, and expressed their concerns that the parking restrictions have been inconvenient and that traffic speeds on Ethan Ridge Drive have recently increased.



The street is under the jurisdiction of the county and the county representatives stated that they would consider the extent of the parking restrictions and return with proposals for the area's residents later this week. Among the options being considered is the removal or reduction of the No Parking area along Ethan Ridge Drive. Resident comment will be solicited; please watch for more information to follow.
