Management Update

Please resolve to renew your membership passes early. All households renewed before March 31 will receive an extra 5 (FIVE) guest passes free! To renew, follow the links from the home page of the web site (after you log in). Renewal is free. You need to enter the information for your household; you will receive a confirmation email several days later from management staff reporting that your passes have been updated.

Trash and Recycling Reminder: Please remember that all trash and recycling containers must be stored in the garage if you have one; or in the rear yard if you do not. Trash and recycling containers may not be stored in the driveway or in the front. Please place trash and recycling out for collection no earlier than the evening before your collection day and store the containers promptly at the end of the day.

Christmas Tree Disposal: Real Christmas trees (as opposed to artificial) may be left out for collection with your yard waste on the regular yard waste recycling day.
