## Renew Membership Passes Early

**M**embership Pass Update: NEW for 2018!!! Remember that all membership passes expire on May 1. This year, continuing members will be able to select a "Quick Renewal" option for the membership pass renewal for 2018. This is a good option if there have been no changes in your household. Your household account will be updated EXACTLY as it was in 2017. This is a great option for families that have not changed.

Who should NOT use the Quick Renewal option? Any household that has added or lost members, any household with children who have reached the milestone birthdays of 3 years, 10 years, or 16 years. The links are now active. Whether you are doing the Quick Renewal or the Full Renewal, please remember that if you renew your passes before February 28, 2018 you will receive an additional 7 guest passes - 17 per household total. This is a great value!
