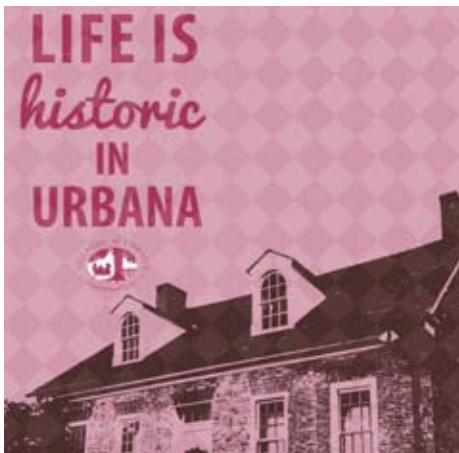
them. This will allow firemen easier access in the case of emergency.
