## The High Cost of Vandalism

As July draws to a close, the cost of repairing vandalism in the community is already more than double what was budgeted for the entire year. On the night of July 25, the Natelli Community Center became the victim of a truly expensive graffiti spree that included paint on curbs, signs, fences, trash cans, dog boxes, the trash shed, and the brick walk around the Fat Oxen. The incidents of stolen signs, broken community assets, and graffiti are being reported to the sheriff's office.



Vandalism is a crime, and it is costing the community a lot of money for repairs and cleanup. If you are a parent, please discuss this issue with your children. The money spent on repairs and cleanup is money that could have been used to fund improvements or events -- or to offset future assessment increases.
