Tavistock Update

Over the past few weeks, the VOU Board of Directors and committees have been made aware of a serious problem involving children playing on the asphalt alley surrounding the Tavistock tot lot. Several residents attended the May Board of Directors and the Physical Assets Management Committee (PAMC) meetings to describe their concerns. At those meetings, differing perspectives were presented, including concerns that vehicles are driving too quickly through the alley as well as the concerns over use of the alley for social and recreational purposes, including cookouts. Board and committee members have visited the area to observe the situation, and the Sheriff's Office has been contacted for information about regulations governing play areas and streets/alleys.

UPDATE: Representatives of the Frederick County Sheriff's office have scheduled a neighborhood meeting for: Thursday, August 2, 2012 7:00 p.m. at the Tavistock Tot Lot to observe conditions and discuss resident concerns.
