Urbana Music Festival This Weekend

The sixth annual Urbana Music Festival and Bistro has grown and changed since its successful start in 2009 and returns on Saturday, June 21, 2014 from 2 PM-7 PM. There will be tables and chairs in the designated Bistro Area. The day of the festival kicks off with a 5K Family Fun Run sponsored by the Frederick YMCA. The music begins at the start of the festival, which will now run from 2 pm-7 pm this year.

Ted Garber's smoky, bluesy vocals, howling harmonica riffs, and screaming guitar licks are enticing audiences and taking fans on a diverse musical journey from the Big Apple to the Big Easy, hovering in the Mississippi Delta before heading South of the Border.

3:30-5:00 pm—Patty Reese Band—With influences including Janis Joplin, Bruce Springsteen, and Aretha Franklin, Patty Reese is winner of eleven WAMMIES, including Album of the Year, Artist of the Year, and Roots Rock Vocalist. With the voice and musicianship on Reese's latest release, Strong Medicine, it couldn't be clearer that the medicine is working.

5:30-7:00 pm—Sol Driven Train—Hailing from Charleston, SC, Sol Driven Train features rotating vocalists as well as horns, strings, and percussion to craft unique and rich music that combines American pop and folk styles with their own port-town sound.
