Turf Applications

The next round of turf applications (herbicide and fertilizer) will begin on Monday, June 19. Please watch for warning flags. The areas should be safe for pets and children 24 hours after application.

4th of July Trash Collection

The week of July 4, trash will be collected on Monday, July 3 as usual, but trash that would normally be placed out for collection on July 4 will be collected on WEDNESDAY, July 5. Please plan accordingly.

Remember to place trash out ONLY inside a plastic bag that is inside a lidded container. If you regularly have overflow trash, please consider getting a second trash can. Birds and animals know that plastic bags potentially contain food and they pick them apart. Even if they are out for only a few hours. Please also remember to contain your recycling completely inside the lidded container or you may fill the bin no higher than the sides of the bin. We all want the VOU to remain clean and pleasant!
