Street Work Continues

As we have noted in the last several newsletters, street sealcoating is scheduled to begin in certain townhouse and neotraditional neighborhoods. Please note the following:

Singleton/Hartwick/Connor/
Winthrop/Caldwell/Burgee
will begin paving this week

Winthrop and Caldwell areas will be sealcoated on Tuesday, June 3. Please remove your vehicles from the area by 7 AM; you will be able to park in front of your home again later in the day on June 4, weather permitting.

The red areas of Singleton, Hartwick and Connor Place are scheduled to be sealcoated and repainted on Monday, June 2. The blue areas of Singleton and Ward are scheduled to be sealcoated and repainted on Tuesday, June 3. The yellow areas of Singleton, Burgee and Connor are scheduled to be sealcoated and repainted on Wednesday, June 4. On each day, please remove your vehicle from the area to be sealcoated by 7 AM; you will be able to access the area again later on the following day. Unauthorized vehicles will be towed.

Due to rain, the sealcoating and repainting of "Area 2" of Village 10 (Penrose, Shawfield, Addison Woods, Kinnerton) was not performed last week. It is presently rescheduled for Thursday, June 5.
