Pre-movie Activity: PNC Grow Up Great – “Learning is All Around Me!” Mobile Learning Adventure. The Mobile Learning Adventure ([link is external](#)) (MLA) is a traveling exhibit that provides an opportunity for parents and caregivers to learn about the importance of early childhood education while they engage in fun activities with their children. A part of PNC Grow Up Great – a \$350 million, multi-year initiative that began in 2004 to help children from birth to age 5 for success in school and life – the MLA includes interactive kiosks and the “When I Grow Up” station, where kids dress up as different professionals and have their picture superimposed on an appropriate background. In addition, parents can take home activity books and learning kits that demonstrate how to take everyday moments and turn them into learning opportunities. Also enjoy meet & greet photo opportunities with beloved movie characters and popcorn.



Management Updates

Trash and Recycling Updates: Please note that there will be no trash collection on Monday, July 4. All trash will be collected on Tuesday, July 5.

Please remember that recyclables cannot be co-mingled with trash, and trash should not be placed out with recyclables. Recyclables include cardboard, paper, metal cans, glass bottles, and certain plastic bottles. All cans and bottles should be cleaned before placing them in the recycling bin. Please do not overfill your containers – you may use blue painter's tape to secure bin lids on windy days. It is YOUR responsibility to clean up recyclables that spill or blow out of your container, so please take the time to secure and properly load the recycling containers. Containers should be placed out no earlier than the Thursday morning of your recycling day. With regard to trash, please remember to contain all trash within a closed plastic bag inside a lidded vermin-proof container for removal. It is a violation to place plastic bags of trash out for collection outside of a trash can.

Traffic Safety: Please remember that streets are for vehicular use. Streets are NEVER safe places to play. VOU encourages all children and families to play on designated greenspaces and tot lots. In recent weeks, children playing in the streets have caused damage to parked cars and are at risk of injury from drivers. Please direct your children to play in designated play areas.

Pet Reminders: Please note that pet owners are required to clean up after their pets. Please note that it is against community rules and Frederick County law for a dog owner to permit the dog to bark such that it causes a nuisance. In the VOU, dogs are not permitted to be outside without their owners. Please make sure that your pet is attended, that you clean up after your animal, and that the pet is not causing a nuisance by barking.
