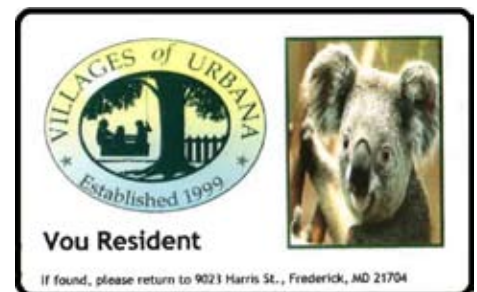

Pool Passes Required for Pool Entry

As a reminder, pool passes expire annually. All members must have a valid photo ID membership pass to enter the pools. Renewal is free and easy from the link on the home page. Last year all bar code passes should have been replaced with the new microchip passes (with a color logo on the left side). If you do not have the new passes, they are \$5 apiece, payable by check at the management office or by credit card online.



Does your pool pass look like this? If not, you need to get a new pass.

If you have lost your pool pass, you must get a replacement before you will be able to enter the pools. Please visit the onsite management office at 9023 Harris Street any time during regular business hours (10 AM to 4 PM weekdays). Additional hours may be arranged by appointment.
