Water Exercise is COOL!

Check out our summer classes at the VOU Harris Street Pool. 2016 Classes run from June 21st – August 3rd, Wednesdays 7:00 – 7:45 PM. Shallow Water Workout: A low impact but high intensity water aerobics class where no swimming skills are needed.
