Frederick County's Office of Sustainability & Environmental Resources (OSER)'s expanded Neighborhood Green program helps landowners in the Peter Pan Run watershed control stormwater runoff and reduce pollutants from entering our local waterways feeding into the Chesapeake Bay.

IF YOUR PROPERTY QUALIFIES, HOMEOWNERS WILL RECEIVE:

- A FREE assessment of your property which includes an urban nutrient management plan and a landscape plan with suggestions for management (\$200 value).
- For a small homeowner cost-share of \$100, grant funds originating from outside of the County will provide up to \$400 for practices recommended by the contractor.

WHY PARTICIPATE? Polluted stormwater affects the water that we use for drinking, swimming and fishing, and contributes to stream erosion. Implementing these actions will attract birds and pollinators while beautifying your property and they will have a beneficial and lasting impact on our stream and watershed health.
