## Homeowner's Workshop Planned for Neighborhood Green Program

Frederick County's Office of Sustainability & Environmental Resources (OSER) will be offering an expanded Neighborhood Green program to help eligible landowners in your area create personalized plans for their properties to control stormwater runoff and reduce pollutants from entering our local waterways that feed into the Chesapeake Bay. Each participating homeowner will receive: A personalized "stormwater audit" for your property (valued at \$200) performed by a qualified contractor hand-selected for the program.



Should you choose, installation of one or more stormwater filtration practices on your property by a qualified contractor chosen by OSER. For a \$100 homeowner contribution, the grant will provide up to a \$400 cost-share to you for practices recommended by the landscape plan in your stormwater audit. The practices include beautiful rain gardens, conservation landscaping, tree plantings, downspout disconnections and rain barrels. Implementing these actions will attract birds and pollinators while beautifying your property! They will also have a beneficial and long-lasting impact on our stream and watershed health.
