Road Work Ahead!

On or about March 29, road patching is planned for the areas of Singleton, Winthrop and Caldwell. Access to driveways and parking may be intermittently affected. Residents of those areas will receive additional information as the date approaches.

On or about April 5 and 6, the tree line behind Brien Alley is scheduled to receive a major pruning. Access to the alley will be intermittently blocked during the day. Please do not park your car on the alley during that week.

The following neighborhoods are scheduled to be sealcoated this year. This work affects all alleys and streets owned and maintained by the VOU (streets maintained by Frederick County are not involved).

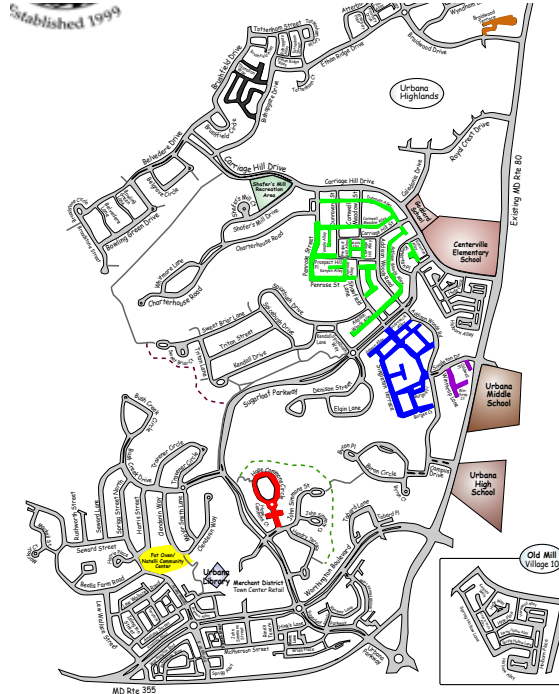
- Hope Commons April 9-13
