## Snow Tips

The heavy snow a week ago has caused some problems in the neighborhood. Please note the following tips:

- As the snow melts, please check around your home's gutter and downspouts to make sure they are not blocked with ice.
- Please clear snow away from fire hydrants and storm drains in the street.
- Please remember to clean up your pet's waste even in snowy weather. Dog poo does not melt!
- Please remember to walk your dog only on your own property or community property, and to vary the route that you follow. It is a violation of county law to leave dog waste on anyone's property but your own.
- On county roads, if you must park during and after snow storms, please park your car within 12 inches of the curb. County plows cannot clear snow around parked cars and the number of cars parked during the last storm left many roads with very narrow driving areas.
- Please do not clear snow off your car or driveway and leave it in the street. After plows have finished their work, they do not generally return to an area. The snow piles from cleared cars cause significant problems.
- Remember that during a snow storm, plows clear a single driving lane. Roads are not cleared edge to edge until the storm is over.
- Snow that reaches a depth less than 2 inches is not usually plowed, but we will clear townhouse sidewalks, particularly near the schools. Residents of single family homes are responsible for clearing the walks in front of their homes.
