## Update Your Membership Passes Today

**R**enew those passes! Please remember that the closer we get to the date of pool opening, the longer it takes to renew passes because so many people wait until the last minute. Renewal can take up to 5 business days right now, but by the first of May it may be substantially more. Please send in your form as soon as possible. Waiting until the day before the pool opens will mean that you cannot get in!



Pool season begins May 28 at 10 AM. Be sure to have your pool passes ready. No-one will be admitted to the pool without a valid pass in hand. The actual physical pass will be required.
