Concrete Work Planned

From May 8 through 12, concrete repairs are planned throughout the Villages of Urbana, primarily in the Hope Commons, Singleton, Old Mill and Atterbury areas. Affected homeowners will be provided with specific maps of the work. This work is highly weather dependent. Please do not park near the affected areas after 7 AM each day of the week of May 8 until the work in each area is done. Please do not permit your children to write in fresh concrete, as this is considered vandalism and can reduce the lifespan of the concrete.

Asphalt repairs are planned for the week of May 15 in the Singleton area. Please move your vehicles out of the marked repair areas by 7 AM that morning. If weather delays the work, it will proceed on May 16. Maps and additional information will be provided to residents of the Singleton area. Asphalt sealcoat will be installed in the Atterbury area from June 5 to June 6. Half of the neighborhood will be done each day. Additional information will be provided as the dates approach.

Saturday Morning Junior Tennis

On Saturday mornings, May 6, 13, 20 & 27, the tennis staff of ITC Tennis will be offering junior tennis instruction at the Villages of Urbana. For young children, the program will feature hand-eye skills, balance, and fundamental tennis skills. Also, the program will feature the quick start format using special balls and nets for maximum learning and fun.
