The Spring Fling will include a rock climbing wall, DJ entertainment, pony rides, moon bounces, a photo booth, carnival games with prizes, a kids' craft room, face painters, a beer garden, a scavenger hunt, the Gourmet Gang selling food, and many vendors offering various giveaways and attractions.
