Do You Know this Child?

This young man climbed a chain link fence around a pond, posted with a No Trespassing sign, in the area of Kenway/Landon House/Worthington on May 10. After climbing in, he chased the ducks that have made the pond their home and harassed them. While he was walking in the pond, his friends threw school papers over the fence, creating a mess of litter. Unfortunately, the residents who witnessed these events were not able to identify the children.



As a reminder: the ponds are all fenced and posted No Trespassing. This is to protect the pond areas AND wildlife AND residents. The pond areas include many engineered structures, including the low dam on which this boy is walking, which can easily be damaged. Pipes and buried valves can trap or trip feet. These ponds are not play areas. The litter will be cleaned up at the expense of all VOU residents. PLEASE speak with your children and ask them to stay out of the ponds. The fences are there to protect them and the facilities. The costs of repair and cleanup are high and all residents must share them. If you see people in the ponds, please report trespassers to the on-site management office. It is helpful if you can get their names and addresses so that we can follow up. After regular business hours, you may also notify the police at 301-600-2071, as trespassing is treated as a crime and the police will respond.
