Processing time for renewals is approximately 3 to 5 business days. After your renewal is processed, you will receive a personalized email from staff confirming that the form has been processed. If you have not received such an email, please first check your spam/junk file, as the email may have gone there. Another way to see if your passes have been renewed is to visit the Shafer's Mill Recreation Center and see if an adult pass will open the front doors for the gym. The VOU Spring Fling is an annual free community event held on the grounds of the Natelli Community Center. **Those who RSVP'd for May 19 are assumed to be coming on June 2. There is no need to respond again.** It will be held from 1 – 4 p.m. this year. The Spring Fling will include a rock climbing wall, DJ entertainment, pony rides, moon bounces, a photo booth, carnival games with prizes, a kids' craft room, face painters, a beer garden, a scavenger hunt, the Gourmet Gang selling food, and many vendors offering various giveaways and attractions.

- **Pond B (intersection of Bush Creek and Sugarloaf Parkway) – starting May 15**
- **Pond G (Sugarloaf Parkway below Hope Commons) – starting May 15**
- **Pond N (Sugarloaf Parkway below Denison) – starting May 22**
- Pond R (behind Sweet Briar Court and Triton Lane) – starting July 2
- Pond C (between Travener Circle and Bush Creek Circle) – starting July 31
- Pond A1 (behind Clendenin Way) – starting August 24
- Pond F (behind Hendry Terrace) – starting September 26
- Pond J (behind Byron Place) – starting September 28
- Pond S (behind Sweet Briar Lane) – starting September 28
- Pond L (Addison Woods Road between Campus Drive and Singleton) – starting October 18
- Pond FF (Winthrop Lane at Route 80) – starting October 22
- Pond M1 (Connor Place at Addison Woods Road) – starting October 24
