Tree and Large Shrub Removal

Some parts of VOU are as much as 16 years old and original builder-provided plantings have grown to the point that they become detractors from the "street view" of homes and are candidates for removal. While changes in flowers and low growing ground cover items can be made without requiring submission of a Design Review Applications, removal of trees or large evergreen shrubs do require submission and approval of review applications-before removal of the items.
