Asphalt and Concrete Work

Due to wet weather, the VOU has postponed crackseal work in the following areas until approximately September 15: Gantt's Glade (Winthrop/Caldwell); Hope Commons; alleys near Kinnerton, Shawfield, Addison Woods, Prospect Hill, Cornwell Meadow, Dunraven, and Penrose; Singleton, Burgee and Connor Place; Braidwood Terrace. This work will not affect parking, but will leave the streets a bit sticky for a few hours. Please watch your step! The VOU is scheduling concrete work for October. More information will follow about the exact schedule. If you see a green mark on the concrete near your house, that indicates that VOU work is planned.
