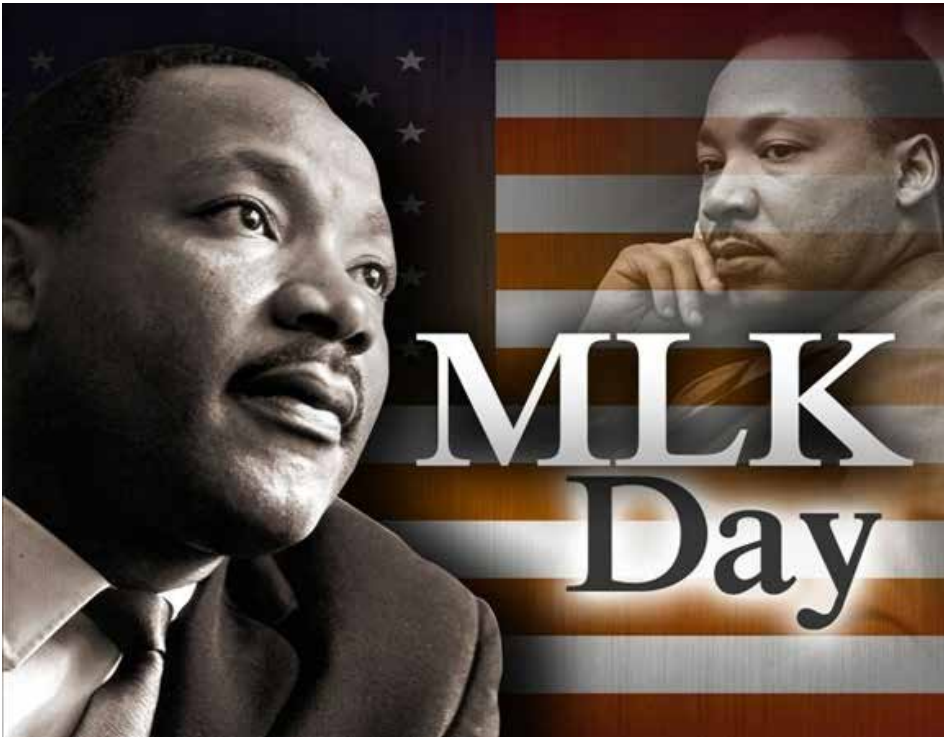

VOU Snow Plan

The Villages of Urbana has a detailed snow plan. To view it, please visit the website and navigate to Resources>Landscaping, Trash & Snow Removal. Please remember that streets with green street signs are county roads and are cleared by Frederick County. To contact Frederick County Highway Operations, please call 301-600-1564. All alleys and streets with white street signs are maintained by the Villages of Urbana. For more information, call the management office at 301-831-4810.



Snow will be cleared or plowed only if accumulations exceed two inches. The VOU will shovel the sidewalks (not lead walks) in the townhouse and condominium areas. Owners of single family homes on county roads are responsible for shoveling the sidewalks adjacent to their homes. The VOU collects names of people who are willing to shovel here.
