COMMUNITY SCOOP

Winter is COMING!

A few quick reminders as we prepare for what may be a wet and wild winter. Please check your gutters and downspouts to make sure they are clean and functioning. Leaves and debris in the gutters can cause ice dams, which can lead to leaks and roof damage. Please clear leaves away from storm drains – and never rake leaves into drains, as this can cause the drains to clog, leading to flooding. Finally, please check to make sure that the water to your exterior hoses has been turned off. The pipes can freeze and break, causing damage to your home.

Safe Driving Reminder

Please watch for school children! In Frederick County, every intersection is considered a crosswalk, even if it is not marked. The office has received concerns about pedestrian safety in the new Stone Barn area. Please stop for pedestrians entering the crosswalks in that area. The Association has also received complaints about traffic safety on Addison Woods Road during school pick up and drop off times. Please do not block through traffic on Addison Woods Road.
