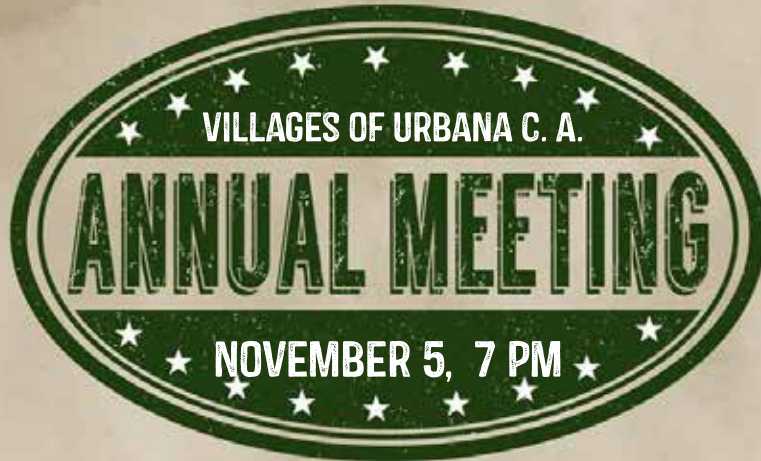

Safe Driving Reminder

Please watch for school children! In Frederick County, every intersection is considered a crosswalk, even if it is not marked. The office has received concerns about pedestrian safety in the new Stone Barn area. Please stop for pedestrians entering the crosswalks in that area. The Association has also received complaints about traffic safety on Addison Woods Road during school pick up and drop off times. Please do not block through traffic on Addison Woods Road.

Maintenance Work Planned

Please note that several maintenance items are planned for the week of November 12 - 16. Crackseal will be applied to cracks in the alley and community-maintained street surfaces in Old Mill Condominium (Hyde Place, Knights Walk, Spring Hollow Lane, Holborn Place); Town Center 1 (alleys behind Katherine, Worthington, McPherson, Sprigg, Mantz, Rines Tavern and Brien); Town Center 2 (alleys behind Amelung, Sprigg Street, Lew Wallace, Bealls Farm, Tavistock, and Islington). Please do not step on fresh crackseal, as it may leave marks on interior flooring. The landscapers will be applying fertilizer to community-maintained greenspaces starting November 12. No herbicides are being applied. Some concrete work will be performed on the alley behind Amelung at Sprigg Street South. The VOU is not performing any other concrete work this year -- all current concrete work is being performed by Frederick County.

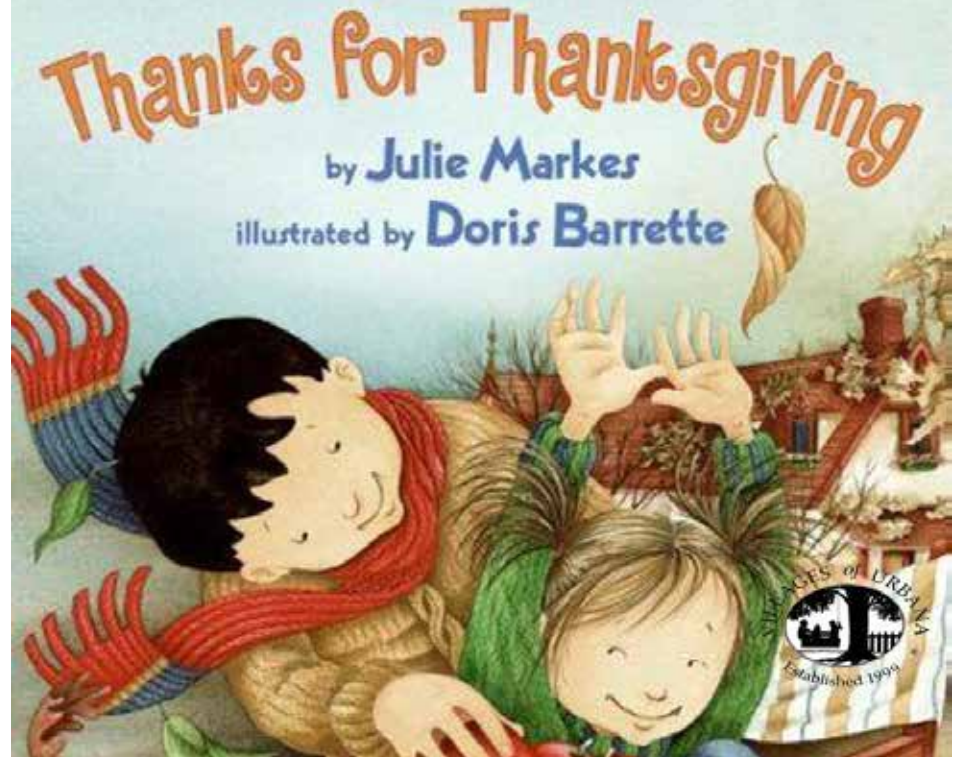
